CLIMATE

- Spring in South Africa starts anything from September to October.
- Summer is anything from November to February.
- Autumn - Winter sets in from about May and last until August.
- Our summers are warmer and winters moderate.
- Best enquire when making your reservation, pending the period and region you are going to visit.

WHAT TO BRING WITH?

- Good set of binoculars
- Hunting and or safari clothing, camo is legal in South Africa (3 sets-daily laundry service)
- Suitable headwear for sun protection preferably in natural colours (full brim hat)
- Comfortable shoes for bush wear, serious hunters and hikers should consider ankle boots (Do not bring new shoes!)
- Camera and video equipment to capture the beauty you will witness, in the evening a flash light could be handy as well as a pocketknife.
- Sun protection creams
- Where needed, physical health awareness for changes in routine could influence your health.
- Enough batteries for anything that runs on batteries.
- Electrical converter (between 110V and 220V) and adaptor to South African size.
- Books to read
- Photocopies of your passport and medical prescriptions in case you lose them. Keep them separate from the rest of your luggage.
- Rifle and ammunition or bow and arrows (See Weapons and Ammo below)

PAYMENTS ETC.

Please be advised that we do not accept Travelers Cheques, American Express, or Discovery cards at the Ranch. We do however except all other Visa and MasterCard Cards. **You must notify your bank that you are going to use your cards in South Africa.**

We have a 3% service charge should you wish to pay with your credit cards. We do accept Cash (US\$) and gratuities may be paid in cash too. There is a Bureau de Change at the airport should you wish to use it. *Some clients prefer to wire funds into our account before they arrive to waive the 3% service charge. You may wire funds to our Bank in South Africa.*

WEAPONS & AMMO

- Recommended firearms for hunting in South Africa:
 - 30.06 calibre or larger,
 - 180 grain bullets or heavier,
 - Bolt action or muzzle loader.
 - 2 WEAPONS OF THE SAME CALIBER NOT ALLOWED

 - The following firearms are NOT allowed to enter South Africa:
 - Any fully automatic weapon
 - Any semi-automatic weapon
 - Handguns (Pre-approved import permits necessary 60 days prior to arrival.)
 - Weapons that fall under military categories

 - Airlines require a heavy plastic or metal gun case for transportation of firearms.
 - Check with your airline for regulations on the amount of ammunition allowed and the packing requirements.
 - Per South African regulations, a maximum of 80 rounds of ammunition can enter the country.
 - Ammunition must be transported in your packed luggage.
 - Paperwork for rifles:
 - Copy of your US4457 form – Customs form- see example below
 - Copy of your Passport
 - Copy of your return ticket
 - Invitation letter from Authentic African Adventures
 - SAPS520 form can be downloaded off the SAPS Website at www.saps.gov.za
- Very important!**
Keep in your hand
luggage for easy
access.
- Notes on completing the SAPS520 form:
 1. Black ink must be used to fill in the form.
 2. The form should be left unsigned until the document is finalized in front of the police official issuing the actual permit.
 3. Please note that not all sections of the form apply. Visitors bringing their own firearms in for hunting purposes should concentrate on filling in the following:
 - Section D – (temporary import or export permit)
 - Section E – 1 – 25.4
 - Section G
 - Section I – (Must fill in all details requested)
 - Section J - (remember do not sign until in front of police officer at firearm office)

No paperwork is needed when bringing a bow and arrows
